Please note: TPC Scottsdale will be overseeding September 9—22, 2013. During the first few weeks after over seeding our course conditions will be as follows:

- The greens will be slower than prime season conditions
- Golf carts will be restricted to the cart paths on the Champions Course until course has sufficiently matured (exact date is TBD and is dependent upon weather conditions)
- The course will be wetter than in prime season conditions due to heavy watering
- The fairways and tees will be mowed to a higher height than normal and as the grass matures, the height of the cut will be lowered
